TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1: Sun., Oct. 18: Depart Toronto flight number LY30 AT 18:30.

In our two days in Tel Aviv we'll experience the current metropolis, the first Hebrew city established in the modern era, and its origins from the old port of Jaffa. Through visiting different sites and strolling various neighbourhoods, we'll become familiar with the old, the new, and how it all fits together.

In the north we'll encounter the site of Elijah's encounter with the 450 prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18) and view a special synagogue decorated with

excellent mosaics of the Biblical narrative. We'll also see the seaside grottos at Rosh Hanikra. In Magdala, we visit an ancient fishers' village from the time of Yeshua with a synagogue built before the destruction of the Second Temple. The site has expanded to include a new and unique chapel.

Day 6: Fri. Oct. 23

In Tzfat, we'll walk through picturesque, ancient alleyways, visiting the artists' quarter, the synagogue and renowned candle-making shop. The Biblical site

of Tel Hazor dates from the time of King Solomon. We'll also enjoy a sunset tour to watch migrating flocks of birds.

We visit the magnificent reconstructed city from the Byzantine, Roman and Arabic periods and one of the world's oldest cities near the Mount of Temptation. We'll also experience the original site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were written and later hidden. The temperature of the Dead Sea will be very comfortable for swimming or floating.

Day 9: Mon. Oct 26

We'll start our day with a bird's eye view from the Mt. of Olives, the best place to gain a panoramic understanding of the story of Jerusalem, the Temple and Yeshua's last days. We'll walk down the Palm Sunday Road and visit Domus Flavit and Gethsemane. Then we examine the old city of Jebus and archaeological excavations from the times of King David and Hezekiah, the water projects, Pool of Siloam, the newly opened Pilgrim's Road and the Southern Steps. Underground excavations along the

Western Wall give us valuable insights on the building of the Temple.

Then we will walk through a major archeological site and the burial location of Herod. We will visit the Temple Mount, the site of both of Judaism's ancient Temples. We'll go to the location of one of the most famous battles fought in Jerusalem.
